Personal pronouns replace nouns in a sentence. They take on different forms when they are a subject or an object.

Subject Pronouns

Subject pronouns replace the subject of a sentence.

	FIRST PERSON	SECOND PERSON	THIRD PERSON
SINGULAR	I	You	He, She, It
PLURAL	We	You	They

Direct Object Pronouns and Indirect Object Pronouns

Direct object pronouns and indirect object pronouns replace the direct object and indirect object in a sentence, most with a different form.

SUBJECT PRONOUNS	DIRECT/INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS
I	me
you	you
he	him
she	her
it	it
we	us
they	them
